Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with the original cor. set alongside and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Ascend 65 ft. over washland, drains SW.

20.00 Enter a wash, course W.

27.00 Leave wash, course W.; foot of hills, bears E. and W.; ascend 140 ft. on rocky S. slope.

40.30 A rocky spur, slopes W.; descend 33 ft.

41.07 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36; a limestone, 26x16x8 ins., set in a mound of stone 2 ft. base and 1 ft. high and marked with 1 notch on S., 5 notches on N. side.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with the original stone corner set alongside, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

East on a random line on S. bdy. sec. 31.

40.40 A point 5 lks. N. of the stan. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
from cor.,

Thence, east on a random line on S. bdy. sec. 31.

40.00 Find no trace of stan. cor. of secs. 31 and 32; set temp. cor.

Continue line and measurement on S. bdy. sec. 32.

80.70 A point 10 lks. N. of the stan. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; a mesquite stake 2 ins. sq., 1 ft. above a mound of stone and earth 2 ft. base and 1 ft. high; and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. side.
