From the clos. cor. of T.25 S., Rs.56 and 57 E.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the Von Schmidt California-Nevada Boundary resurveyed in T.24 S., R.56 E., under this group.

North on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

35.69 A point 28 lks. W. of the orig. clos. cor. of T.25 S., Rs.56 and 57 E., hereinafter described.

At a point on the 6th Stan. Par. S., S. bdy. of sec. 36, T.24 S., R.56 E.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a quart beer bottle deposited at the base, for clos. cor. of T.25 S., Rs.56 and 57 E., with brass cap marked

dig a circular

trench 5-ft.diam.and pile the dirt around post to top.

From this point the stan. cor. of T.24 S., Rs.56 and 57 E., bears S.88°27'E., 2.04 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the 6th Stan. Par. S., S. bdy. of frac. T.24 S., R.56 E., resurveyed under this group.

Thence, S.0°28'W., on true line bet. frac. secs. 1 and 6.

Over level land, thru scattering undergrowth.

.11 The orig. clos. cor. of T.25 S., Rs.56 and 57 E.; a mesquite stake 2 ins. sq., 3 ft. above a mound of earth 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high; and marked CC on N., SVI on SE., TXXIVS RLVII SI on SW. sides.

Change the marks CC to WP on this corner.

10.50 Foot of low sand hills, bear E. and W.

12.00 Top of sand hill, 14 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.

15.00 Foot of sand hills, bears NW. and SE.

33.60 Road, bears NW. and SE. to Sandy.

35.80 The closing cor. of T.25 S., Rs.56 and 57 E., on Von Schmidt boundary line.

Thence, south on true line bet./secs. 1 and 6.

5.75 A point which is 40.00 chs. in latitude from the clos. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T.25 S., R.57 E., hereinafter described.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a quart beer bottle deposited at the base, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
