	17.00 A road, bears NE 1 mile, and SW to Kingston.	00.71
	26.30 A road, bears S 36 S 36 to Sandy.	00.30
	1932 dig a circular trench 5 ft.diam. and pile the dirt around post to top.	
	Thence, S.45°00'E., on true line. Over rolling desert land, drains SW., thru undergrowth.	
23.00	A wash, 1 ch. wide, course east; ascend 315 ft. over a rocky N. slope.	
44.00	Top of ridge, bears E. and W.; descend 320 ft. over a rocky S. slope.

	The stan. cor. of T.24 S., Rs.56 and 57 E., is a mesquite stake 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. above a mound of earth, 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high; marked SC on S., TXXIVS RLVII on NW., and TXXIVS RLVIIIE SXXXI on NE. sides.	
	At point for cor. Set an iron post 3 ft. long 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a quart beer bottle deposited at the base and the original stake set alongside, for stan. cor. of T.24 S., Rs.56 and 57 E., with brass cap mkd.	
	S C T 24 S R 56 E R 57 E S 36 S 31 T 25 S R 57 E S 6	
	1932 dig a circular trench 5 ft.diam. and pile the dirt around post to top.
