	From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on W. bdy. of Tp. South, on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36. Desc. 40 ft. over rolling land, thru light undergrowth.
13.60	A wash, 2 chs. wide, course S. 75° E.; asc. 30 ft. over bank.
16.20	Top of bank, bears SE. and NW.; desc. 45 ft. on SE. slope.
24.50	A road and pipe line, bears NE. to Rex Bell ranch and SW. to Malpais Spring.
39.50	A road, bears NE. and SW.
40.05	A point midway in latitude bet. the NW. cor. and the closing cor. on the S. bdy. of frac. sec. 31, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 S31 1933 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Desc. 35 ft. on SW. slope.
51.50	Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone, mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of frac. Ts. 29 S., Rs. 61 and 62 E., with brass cap mkd. T29S R61E R62E S36 S31 C C CAL 1933
	From this point the 3 mile cor. bet. monuments 130 and 132 on the State boundary bears S. 45° 48' E., 4.75 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group. Land, rolling, low hills. Soil, gravelly, 3d rate. Undergrowth, joshua, cactus, yucca and sage.

40.22	A point 54 lks. S. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.37	A point 38 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32; a granite stone, 18x10x5 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone and marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. side.
