Chains.	Ascend 158 ft. over W. slope.
14.00	Top of rocky hill bears NW. and SE.; desc. 274 ft. over E. slope, slide rock and loose boulders.
32.90	Foot of descent, bears N. and S.; continue over rolling land.
40.55	The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, hereinbefore described. Land, mountainous and rolling. Soil, malpais rock; 4th rate. No timber. Undergrowth, scattered creosote brush, sage, cactus and yucca.
	From the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23. South on a random line bet. secs. 22 and 23.
40.00	Find no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. cor.
80.00	Find no trace of the original cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27; continue line and measurement bet. secs. 26 and 27.
116.17	Record dist; find no trace of the original closing cor. of frac. secs. 26 and 27.
	Return to the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23. Thence South on a true line bet. secs. 22 and 23. Over rolling and mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth. Descend 115 ft. along SE. slope.
21.30	Enter wash, course E.
24.00	Leave wash at foot of mountain, bears E. and W.; asc. 275 ft. over N. slope.
40.09	At this point which is midway/bet. the NW. cor. of sec. 23, and the closing cor. of frac. secs. 23 and 26 on the state boundary, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 22 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
	Ascend 706 ft. over N. slope.
