

Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisions of
Fractional T.30 S., R. 62 E.

Chains.

At a point on the California-Nevada State Boundary, south
of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, on N. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6 with brass cap mkd.

$\frac{1}{4}$ S6
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raise a mound,

of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

From this point the 4 mile cor. bet. monuments 130 and
132 on the state boundary, bears S.45°47'E., 31.75 chs.
dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the
California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this
group.

There is no final test of the solar attachment to be
recorded, The bearings of all lines in this township were
checked, by deflection from the line of the California-
Nevada State Boundary.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in the resurveyed portion of T. 30 S., R. 62 E.,
is rolling desert washland and mountainous. The soil is
sandy loam; 2nd rate, and rocky, 4th rate, producing Joshua
yucca, creosote brush, cactus and sage brush, Scattering
juniper, timber is found in portions of the township.

There is no surface water in the township, and no wells.
