Chains. Return to the temp. cor. of Tps. 30 and 31 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E.

Thence

North on a random line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

40.00 Find no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 Find no trace of the original cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. Set temp. cor.

With continuous measurement, I continue North bet. secs. 25 and 30.

120.00 Find no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. cor.

162.05 A point 63 lks. W. of the original cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, which is a malpais stone, 20x12x6 ins., set in a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on N. side.

At point for cor. with the original stone alongside,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., on surface rock, with a cross X mkd. at the base, and in a mound of stone to top; for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, with brass cap mkd.
