Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd rate; and rocky, 4th rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, scattered catchlaw, yucca, cactus and sage.

South, on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth.

Ascend 8 ft.

4.00 Top of ascent; desc. 162 ft.

16.51 Wash, 30 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 199 ft. over NE. slope.

24.01 Drain, course NE.

37.51 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of frac. Tps. 30 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E., with brass cap mkd.

From point of intersection the 2 mile cor. bet. monuments 133 and 134 on the state boundary, bears S.45°45'E., 4.55 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

Land, rolling mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 4th rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, scattered catchlaw, cactus and sage.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30.

North on a random line bet. secs. 19 and 24.

39.58 A point 12 lks. W. of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a catchlaw post, 2 ins. sq., 2 ft. long, set in a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. side.

The true course and distance for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile bet. secs. 19 and 24, is therefore N.0°10'E., 39.58 chs. dist.
