From this point the 2 mile cor. bet. monuments 133 and 134 on the state boundary, bears N. 45° 45' W., 1.91 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

There is no final test of the solar attachment to be recorded. The bearing of all lines in this township were determined, or checked, by deflection from the line of the California-Nevada State Boundary.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The land within sec. 31 of this township is rolling and mountainous. The valley soil is sandy loam, generally 2nd rate. The mountain soil is malpais stone 4th rate.

The undergrowth is scattering desert growth and consists of creosote brush, joshua, cactus, yucca and sage brush.

There is no water in this section; and no timber.
