29.27	Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of frac. secs. 22 and 23, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 23, with brass cap mkd.
