

Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisions of

13

Fractional T. 32 S., R. 64 E.

Chains. Ascend 31 ft. over W. slope. to the cor. of sec. 10 and 15.

5.93 Top of ridge, bears N. and SE.; desc. 80 ft.

33.99 Wash, 40 lks. wide, course S. 89° 26' E.

39.99 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 14x10x8 ins. above ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. side.

At point for corner with original stone alongside,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Thence
S. 89° 26' E., on a true line bet. secs. 10 and 15.
Over rolling desert land, through scattered undergrowth.

39.98 The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.

Land, rolling.
Soil, gravelly; 3rd rate.
No timber.
Undergrowth, scattered creosote brush, cactus, catclaw and yucca.

From the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.
South on a random line bet. secs. 15 and 16.

38.90 A point 6 lks. E. of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 18x12x10 ins. above ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. side, and witnessed by a mound of stone W. of cor.
I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

Continue line and measurement bet. secs. 15 and 16.

78.99 A point 11 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, hereinbefore described.

Thence from cor.
S. 1° 13' E., on a random line bet. secs. 21 and 22, the objective corner being visible.

6.83 Intersect the original closing cor. of frac. secs. 21 and 22 on the Von Schmidt State Boundary, which is a granite stone, 8x5x4 ins. above ground, set in a mound of earth, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked 4 notches on N. side.

This corner is not destroyed for the reason that it is used in connection with the survey of Tract 40 in T. 12 N., R. 20 E., S.B.M., California.
