

Chains. Descend 204 ft. over SW. slope.

72.40 Foot of descent, bears N. and S.; continue over rolling land.

82.62 The original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9, which is a juniper post, 2 ins. sq., 36 ins. long, lying on top of a mound of earth, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked with 5 notches on S. 4 notches on E. and SV on NW. sides, other marks illegible.

At point for corner with original post alongside.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9, with brass cap mkd.

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dig a circular trench 4 ft. diam., and pile the dirt around post to top.

Land, rolling and mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 4th rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, scattered greasewood; cactus, creosote brush, catclaw, and yucca.

South on a random line bet. secs. 8 and 9.

40.00 Find no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

84.29 A point 492 lks. dist. W. from the temp. cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16, and 17. Continue line and measurement south bet. secs. 16 and 17.

89.13 Record dist.; find no trace of the original closing cor. of frac. secs. 16 and 17.

From this point the 597 mile cor. on the Von Schmidt State Boundary, bears S. 51° 04' E., 21.62 chs. dist.; an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Return to the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9.

Thence

South on a true line bet. secs. 8 and 9.

Over rolling desert land, through scattered undergrowth.

22.30 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of frac. secs. 8 and 9, with brass cap mkd.
