

Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisions of

Fractional T.32 S., R. 65 E.

secs. 5 and 31, Tps. 32 and 33 S., R. 65 E., on the state boundary,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 22 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

From this point, monument 138 on the state boundary, bears N.45°38'W., 12.04 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

There is no final test of the solar attachment to be recorded. The bearings of all lines in this township were checked by deflection from the line of the California-Nevada State Boundary.

The land within sec. 31 on this township is rolling and hilly. The valley soil is sandy 2nd rate. The hilly soil is gravelly 3rd rate; and rocky 4th rate.

The undergrowth is scattered desert growth, and consists of scattered creosote brush, greasewood, catclaw, cactus, yucca and sage.

There is no water in this section and no timber.
