S.0°43'W., on a true line bet. secs. 14 and 15.

Over rolling desert land, through scattered undergrowth.

Descend 104 ft. over SE. slope.

19.77 Road, bears SE. and NW. in wash, 250 lks. wide, course SE. Asc. 25 ft.

29.87 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of frac. secs. 14 and 15, with brass cap mkd.

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From point of intersection, the 3 mile cor. bet. monuments 139 and 141 on the state boundary, bears N.45°36'W., 37.02 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

Land, rolling.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd rate; and rocky, 4th rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, scattered creosote brush, cactus, yucca and sage.

From the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24.

North on a random line bet. secs. 13 and 14.

40.15 A point 7 lks. E. of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Thence from cor.

North on a random line bet. secs. 13 and 14.

40.20 A point 12 lks. E. of the original cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, which is a granite stone, 13x10x10 ins. set in a mound of stone, marked with 4 notches on S. and 1 notch on E. side.

At point for corner with original stone alongside,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14, with brass cap mkd.
