

Resurvey of a Portion of the East Boundary of

T. 23 N., R. 8 E.

Chains.

73.58 The clos. cor. of sec. 1, R. 8 E., on the California-Nevada State Boundary, an iron post 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record. As this is also the point for clos. cor. of sec. 18, R. 9 E., I add marks on brass cap of post to read as follows:

From this point the $4\frac{1}{2}$ mile cor. bet. monuments 108 and 109 on the state boundary bears S. $46^{\circ}22'$ E., 1.22 chs. dist.; an iron post 1 in. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

80.00 The cor. of Ts. 23 and 24 N., R. 8 E., an iron post 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of Frac. T. 24 N., R. 8 E.

Thence, N. $10^{\circ}38'$ W., on random and true line, on E. Bdy. of sec. 36, T. 24 N., R. 8 E.

16.86 The cor. of secs. 7 and 18, T. 23 N., R. 9 E., an iron post 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

As this corner now becomes an angle point, only, on the E. bdy. of sec. 36, R. 8 E., I change the marks on the brass cap to read as follows:

From this point, the orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. secs. 7 and 18, in R. 9 E., bears S. $89^{\circ}03'$ E., 40.25 chs. dist.; a stone $12 \times 5 \times 3$ ins., on a mound of earth, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on top. I obliterate all evidence of this cor.

Thence from angle point,

N. $0^{\circ}21'$ E., on random and true line on E. bdy. of sec. 36

23.43 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 36, R. 8 E.; an iron post 1 in. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

40.07 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 7, T. 23 N., R. 9 E.; an iron post 1 in. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record. I obliterate all evidence of this cor.

63.43 The cor. of secs. 25 and 36, R. 8 E., an iron post 2 ins., diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
