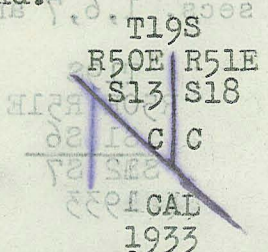
Descend 10 ft. along a SW. slope.
