

## Fractional T. 19 S., R. 51 E.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in the surveyed and resurveyed portion of T. 19 S., R. 51 E., is low rolling and rocky hills, or desert washland. The major drainage is northerly.

The higher portions of the hills are almost barren of undergrowth; small patches of creosote, sage and cacti being the only vegetation. The same undergrowth is somewhat heavier in the valleys. There is no water in the township and the vegetation would make poor grazing.

There is no indication of mineral deposits of any commercial value.

The soil is generally a sandy, gravelly and rocky surface over clayloam, 3d and 4th rate.
