Chains. Desc. 20 ft.
 50.80 Wash, 50 lks. wide, course S.
 68.20 Enter Piute Wash, course S.
 75.20 Leave Piute Wash, course S.
 75.83 Monument 134 on California-Nevada State line, which is a conglomerate stone, 5x8x4 ins. with drill hole in top, lying on top of a mound of earth.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground with the original stone deposited alongside, for 134 mile cor. with brass cap mkd.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/2 mile cor., with brass cap mkd.
