Chains.
51.40 Wash, 30 lks. wide; course SW.; asc. 45 ft.
79.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course SW.
83.73 Monument 137 on the California-Nevada State Boundary,
which is a redwood post, 4 ins. sq., 1 ft. exposed, set
in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, marked with
tacks 137 on NW., N on NE. and C on SW. sides.

Land, rolling.
Soil, gravelly, 3rd rate; and rocky, 4th rate.
Timber, none.
Undergrowth, scattered creosote brush, cactus and yucca.

The flag at Monument 138 being visible, I run
S.45°38'E., on tangent and true line.

Over rolling desert land, through scattered undergrowth.

20.51 Monument 138 on the California-Nevada State Boundary,
which is a redwood post, 4 ins. sq., 6 ins. exposed, set
in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base, 6 ft. high, marked with
tacks, 138 on NW., N on NE. and C on SW. sides; on top
of granite bluff.

Land, rolling SW. slope.
Soil, rocky; 4th rate.
Timber, none.
Undergrowth, scattered cactus, yucca and creosote brush.

The flag at Monument 138 $\frac{1}{2}$ being visible, I run
S.45°38'E., on tangent and true line.

Over rolling desert land, through scattered undergrowth.
Asc. 20 ft. on SW. slope.

15.50 Top and W. end of knoll on divide bet. Piute Valley and
Colorado River.; desc. 52 ft.

19.00 Road, bears SW. and NE. old government road to Fort Mohave.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the
ground to bedrock, with a stone mkd. X, deposited at
the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile
cor., with brass cap mkd.
