chains

N.73°25'W., 6.40 chs. dist.; an unmarked granite stone 16x9x9 ins., set in the top of a mound of stone 3½ ft. base and 2½ ft. high.

I destroy all evidence of these three corners.

From point for unofficial cor. of secs. 7,8,17 and 18, the cor. of secs. 8,9,16 and 17, hereinbefore described, is visible and bears N.89°43'E.

From the cor. of secs. 4,5,8 and 9.

S.89°38'W., on true line bet. secs. 5 and 8.

Over mountainous land, thru scattering undergrowth.

Descend 480 ft. over a SW. slope.

10.00 Head of ravine, course N.75°W.; change to NW. slope.

40.14 Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

41.00 Dividing ridge, bears N.75°W. and S.75°E.; slopes N.75°W.; descend 280 ft. on SW. slope.

61.00 Gulch, near head, course S.; ascend 465 ft. on E. slope.

78.80 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; descend 20 ft.

80.28 Point for cor. of secs. 5,6,7 and 8; determined by single proportion in departure bet. the cor. of secs. 3,4,9 and 10 and the point for ¼ sec. cor. secs. 6 and 7 (destroyed); and at record distance in latitude from the cor. of secs. 5,6,31 and 32, on N. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 5,6,7 and 8, with brass cap marked

28.64 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.
