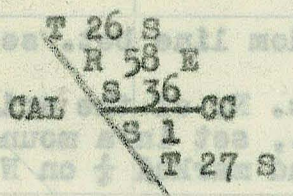


Resurvey of a Portion of the South Boundary of T. 26 S., R. 58 E.

chains

- Return to the cor. of Ts.26 and 27 S., Rs.58 and 59 E.
- Thence, west on true line bet./secs. 1 and 36. frac.
- Over broken hills, thru scattering undergrowth.
- Descend 70 ft. over a bedrock slope.
- 2.10 A wash, 40 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend 55 ft.
- 6.15 A low spur, slopes SW.; descend 70 ft.
- 12.00 A wash, 30 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend 40 ft.
- 17.00 A low spur, slopes SE.; descend 35 ft.
- 22.00 Enter a wash, course SE.
- 26.50 Leave wash, course SE.; ascend 70 ft.
- 29.40 A spur, slopes S. and SW.; descend 100 ft. on broken SW. slope.
- 40.00 No $\frac{1}{2}$ sec.cor.established under this group.
- 45.93 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for clos. cor. of frac. Ts.26 and 27 S., R.58 E., with brass cap marked

From this point the 3 mile cor. bet. monuments 123 and 125 on the state boundary bears N.45°59'W., 16.36 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

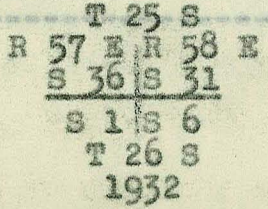
Land, rolling and broken hills.
Soil, rocky, 4th rate.
Undergrowth, scattering creosote brush and cacti.

Resurvey of a Portion of the West Boundary of T. 26 S., R. 58 E.

The cor. of Ts.25 and 26 S., Rs.57 and 58 E., is a mesquite stake, 2 ins. sq., 1 ft. above a mound of stone 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high; and marked TXXVS RLVIIIE on NE., TXXVS RLVIIIE SXXXVI on NW. sides; other marks not legible.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 3 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with the original stake corner set alongside, for cor. of Ts.25 and 26 S., Rs.57 and 58 E., with brass cap marked
