1932 dig a circular

trench 4 ft.diam.and pile the dirt around post to top.

44.90 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a quart beer bottle deposited at the base, for clos. cor. of frac. secs. 8 and 17, with brass cap mkd.

1932 dig a circular

trench 5 ft.diam.and pile the dirt around post to top.

From this point the 1 mile cor. bet. monuments 120 and 121 on the state boundary bears S.46°05'E., 18.54 chs. dist.; an iron post 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground; marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, level valley.

Soil, sandy loam, 1st and 2d rate.

Undergrowth, sage and creosote brush.

From the cor. of secs. 8,9,16 and 17.

North on a random line bet. secs. 8 and 9.

40.00 A point 20 lks. W. of the orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.85 A point 86 lks. E. of the orig. cor. of secs. 4,5,8 & 9.

Return to the cor. of secs.8,9,16 and 17.

Thence, N.0°17'E. on true line bet. secs. 8 and 9. (S $\frac{1}{4}$)

Over level valley land, thru scattering undergrowth.

7.80 Mail route road, bears NE. to Goodsprings and SW. to Kingston.

40.00 The orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; a mesquite stake 2 ins. diam., 1 ft. above a mound of earth 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high; and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. side.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a quart beer bottle deposited at the base, and the original stake set alongside, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
