Reset post firmly in ground at exact cor. point and rebuild the mound of earth.</p> <hr/> <p>Land, nearly level desert land in Pahrump Valley, slight SW. drainage. Soil, sandy and clay, with alkali, 2d rate. Undergrowth, shadscale.
