chains	Land, nearly level; slight SW. drainage. Soil, loose, sandy, gravelly and clay loam, 2d rate. Undergrowth, medium dense shadscale, creosote and greasewood. Timber, scattering mesquite in N $\frac{1}{2}$.
	----- S.46°20'E., on tangent and true line. Over nearly level desert land, thru medium dense short undergrowth.
40.00	Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground in a small mound of stone, for $\frac{3}{8}$ mile cor., with brass cap mkd. CAL \ NEV 3/8 M 1933 dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., NW. and SE. of post, 5 ft. dist.
43.06	Monument 110 on the California-Nevada State Boundary, the stump of a redwood post, 4 ins. sq., rotted off at surface of ground, with a limestone rock marked with drill hole against SE. side of post; the top portion of the redwood post, 4 ins. sq. and 2 ft. long, mkd. with tacks: C on one side, N on opposite side, and 110 on one side, lies on top of the mound of earth. Reset post firmly in ground at exact cor. point and rebuild the mound of earth. Land, nearly level desert land in Pahrump Valley, slight SW. drainage. Soil, sandy and clay, with alkali, 2d rate. Undergrowth, shadscale. No timber.
	----- Record Lat: N.36°05'12"; Longitude: 116°00'26" W. S.46°20'E., on tangent and true line. Over nearly level valley land, thru medium dense shadscale and scattering creosote brush.
24.60	A dim old unused wagen road, bears N.30°W. and S.30°E.
28.83	Top of a slight rise, bears E. and W.
40.00	Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, in a small mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile cor., with brass cap mkd. CAL \ NEV 1/2 M 1933
70.60	An old road, bears N.4°W. and S.4°E.
80.00	Set an iron post 3 ft. long 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, in a small mound of stone, for 1 mile cor., with brass cap mkd. CAL \ NEV 1 M 1933 dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., NW. and SE. of post, 5 ft. dist.
