40.41	A point 5 lks. N. of the orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.73	A point 57 lks. N. of the orig. cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32; a limestone, 6x6x6 ins. above ground, firmly set and marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. sides. At point for cor. Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with orig. stone cor. deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd. T22S R55E <u>S31 S32</u> S6 S5 T23 S 1933
	Thence, N. 89° 15' W., on true line bet. secs. 6 and 31. Over nearly level land, thru medium dense undergrowth.
40.32	The orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; a willow stake, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. long, lying in a mound of stone and bearing illegible scribe marks. At point for cor. Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a rock, 6x4x3 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and the original post set alongside, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 S 6 1933

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with the orig. post set alongside, in a mound of earth to top, for cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 S., Rs. 54 and 55 E., with brass cap mkd. T22S R54E R55E <u>S36 S31</u> S1 S6 T23S 1933
	Land, nearly level, drains SW. Soil, sandy and gravelly, 2d and 3d rate. Undergrowth, creosote and shadscale.
