Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, in a small mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 1 and 12, only, of R.54 E., with brass cap mkd.

1934 dig a circular trench 6 ft. diam. and pile the dirt around post to top. The orig. cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12; a mesquite stake, 4 ins. sq., 3 ft. long, set in a mound of stone 2 ft. base and 2 ft. high, marked as described in the official record.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with the orig. stake set alongside, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 6 and 7, only, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone, mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 1, only, with brass cap mkd.
