Thence, west on a random line on N. bdy. T. 22 S., R. 54 E., setting temp. cors. at record intervals and making diligent but futile search for evidence of orig. cors.

478.42 Find no trace of the cor. of Ts. 21 and 22 S., Rs. 53 and 54 E.; set temp. cor.

Thence, north on a random line in T. 21 S., bet. Rs. 53 and 54 E., making diligent search at record distances for evidence of orig. cors., without success, to

205.75 A point 290 lks. E. of the orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. secs. 19 and 24; a mesquite post 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. above a mound of earth, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. side and witnessed by pits E. and W., about 4 ft. dist.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with the orig. post set alongside, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. secs. 19 and 24, with brass cap mkd.

$\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 S 19

1934 dig a circular trench 6 ft. diam. and pile the dirt around post to top.

From this point the orig. cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24 bears N. 0° 12' W., 40.16 chs. dist.; a mesquite post 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. above a mound of earth, bearing illegible scribe marks.

Return to the cor. of Ts. 21 and 22 S., Rs. 54 and 55 E.

Thence, N. 89° 21' W., on true line bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over nearly level desert land, thru scattering undergrowth.

28.00 A road, bears NE. and SW.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a stone, mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone and earth to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

$\frac{1}{4}$ S 36

1934 dig a circular trench 6 ft. diam. around the post.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

1934 dig a circular trench 6 ft. diam. and pile the dirt around post to top.
