64.15 A road, bears NE. and SW.

84.50 Low point of spur, slopes NW. about 1 ch., from low broken hills extending SE.

91.33 A point which is west of the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8; hereinafter described.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 6 and 7, only, with brass cap mkd.
