Chains

is west, by calculation, of the 1/4 sec. cor. secs. 1 and 6, on E. bdy. of T.24 S., R.55 E.; described in the official record.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. sec. 1, T. 24 S., R.55 E. with brass cap mkd.

1933 raise a mound

of stone 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high east of cor.

From this point monument 117 on the California-Nevada boundary bears N.46°11'W., 15.00 chs. dist.; described in the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

There is no final test of the solar attachment to be recorded. The bearings of all lines in this township were determined, or checked, by deflection from the line of the California-Nevada State Boundary.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The drainage is southwesterly, toward Pahrapump valley. The soil is generally sandy with a loam subsoil, about 2nd rate, somewhat gravelly and rocky.
