Land, rolling mountainous spurs and ravines.  
Soil, sand, gravel and loose boulders, 2d, 3d and 4th rate.  
Timber, pinyon and occasional juniper.  
Undergrowth, light sage and bitter brush, jointfir and mahogany.

S.48°21'E., on tangent and true line.

Desc. 60 ft. on SE. slope, thru timber and light undergrowth.

2.70 Side ravine, 8 lks. wide, course N.70°E.; asc. 210 ft. on N. slope.

13.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 30 ft. along E. slope.

17.70 Ravine, 10 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 340 ft. on N. slope, thru heavy timber.

25.00 Abandoned, graded wood road, bears NE. and SW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, for 4½ mile cor., with brass cap mkd.

A pinyon, 10 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 13 lks. dist., mkd. 4½M NEV BT.

A pinyon, 6 ins. diam., bears S.24°W., 25 lks. dist., mkd. 4½M CAL BT.

Asc. 220 ft. on general NW. slope, thru heavy pinyon.

53.06 Monument 29 on the California-Nevada State Boundary; a pinyon post, 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. exposed above a mound of stone, 5 ft. base and 3 ft. high, marked with tacks: 29 on NW., N on NE. and C on SW. sides.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to drill hole in bedrock, with the old post reset along NW. side, and rebuild the mound of stone to 6 ft. base, around post to top, for Monument 29, with brass cap mkd.
