DEPENDENT RESURVEY,
VON SCHMIDT CALIFORNIA-NEVADA STATE BOUNDARY.

Chains

A tamarack, 16 ins. diam., bears S.51°W., 118 lks. dist., overgrowth on old blaze not cut into. Remarked VS 214 M BT on new blaze.

A tamarack, 20 ins. diam., bears N.½°W., 132 lks. dist., with old marks BT NEV legible on old blaze. Remove the marks NEV.

A tamarack, 16 ins. diam., bears S.86°E., 37 lks. dist., with old marks BT NEV legible on old blaze. Remove the marks NEV.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

A tamarack, 12 ins. diam., bears N.58°E., 101 lks. dist., mkd. VS 214M BT.

Rebuild the mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.

Land, very rough mountainous.

Soil, coarse loam, 2d and 3d rate; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, white bark pine, yellow pine, Jeffrey pine, white fir, red fir, tamarack. Grazing, good.

Undergrowth, second growth timber and mahogany.

S.48°55'E., on Von Schmidt's 215th mile.

Descend 90 ft. on SE. slope, thru timber and undergrowth, over exposed granite outcroppings.

5.40 Draw, course SW.; a small spring seep is 50 lks. SW. of line; ascend 645 ft. along broken W. slope.

30.80 Side spur, slopes SW.

42.80 Broad top of ridge-spur, slopes W.

47.00 Leave top; descend 100 ft. along broken SW. slope, thru scrub timber and undergrowth, over large granite boulders.

70.30 Dividing ridge between Carson and Truckee Rivers, bears N.30°W. and S.30°E.; in saddle at head of ravines, course E. toward Carson River and W. toward Heavenly Valley.

Ascend 140 ft. on NW. slope.

80.00 The 215 mile cor., which is evidenced by a block of charred wood, 4 ins. sq., ½ in. thick, mkd. N on one side, C on the opposite side, in center bottom of a dilapidated mound of stone.
