

Resurvey of a Portion of the Von Schmidt
California-Nevada State Boundary.

Chains	
	Ascend 70 ft. on NW. slope.
48.37	Fence, 4 wires, bears N.30°E. and S.30°W.
50.30	Ditch, 2 ft. wide and 1 ft. deep, course N.25°E.
51.40	A boggy spring, about 15 ft. diam., on line.
52.41	Fence, 3 wires, bears N.18°E. and S.18°W.; leave meadow.
52.70	Old road, now used as a trail, bears parallel to fence; enter pinyon timber on SW. slope; ascend 280 ft.
60.00	Enter area burned over in 1947 fire which killed many of the trees, bears N. and S.
62.56	Drift fence, 4 wires stretched on trees, bears N.70°W. and S.60°E.
72.30	Spur, slopes S.80°W.; ascend 20 ft. along SW. slope.
80.02	The Von Schmidt 230 mile cor., evidenced by the rotted stub of a pine post in center of a mound of earth and scattered mound of stone. Alongside is a portion of the post with legible marks 1873 on one side and 30 on the opposite side.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a flat mound of stone, 6 ft. diam., to top, with brass cap mkd.
	
	A piñon, 8 ins. diam., bears S.32°E., 32 lks. dist., mkd. VS 230 BT.
	A piñon, 9 ins. diam., bears S.67°E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. VS 230 BT.
	Land, rough mountainous, rolling valley, and rolling hills. Soil, shallow clayloam, 2d rate; rocky, 4th rate. Timber, pinyon and yellow pine; scattering scrub juniper. Undergrowth, sagebrush. Grazing poor to good.

	S.48°59'E., on Von Schmidt's 231st mile.
	Ascend 320 ft. on SW. slope, thru pinyon and juniper in 1947 burned area.
24.25	Ridge, bears S.20°W. and N.20°E. Set an unmarked stone, 16x10x3 ins., in mound of stone, 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high.
	Thence along rolling NE. slope
37.50	Change to E. slope; descend 200 ft.
47.70	Abandoned old road, impassable, bears N. and S.
48.10	Rocky ravine, course S.20°W.; ascend 65 ft. along SW. slope.
60.50	Same abandoned old road, bears S.60°E. and N.75°W. Continue at same elevation along SW. slope.
