Chains

49.15 Point for witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7, on W. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 19 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

49.50 True point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7, on W. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 19 E., at record distance. Find no evidence of the original corner. At the corner point

Mark a cross (†) on granite boulder, 6x4x4 ft. above ground, from which

A whitebark pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 45° E., 43 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 7 BT.

A whitebark pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 48° E., 64 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 7 BT.

Ascend 140 ft. on bedrock covered SE. slope.

58.60 High point on ridge bet. Cold Creek and Heavenly Valley, bears N. 35° E. and S. 45° W. Slopes NE. about 5 chs. to a saddle. Descend 180 ft. on N. to NW. slope.

70.50 Head of ravine, course W.; ascend 120 ft.

77.90 Bedrock outcrop on divide between Truckee and Carson Rivers, bears E. and NW.

From this point a triangulation station on Monument Peak bears N. 89° 39' E., 10.30 chs. dist.

Descend 140 ft. on rocky NW. slope, thru scrub pine timber.

83.00 Intersect the Von Schmidt California-Nevada Boundary line.

Point for closing cor. of Ts. 12 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E.

Set a brass tablet, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 3 in. stem, in cement in drill hole in granite boulder, 6x6x3 ft. above ground, mkd.
