

## Dependent Resurvey, E. Bdy. T. 12 N., R. 18 E.

## Chains

The 215 mile cor. on the Von Schmidt line bears S.  $48^{\circ}55'E.$ , 4.11 chs., described in the field notes of the portion of the Von Schmidt California-Nevada State Boundary Line concurrently resurveyed under this group.

Land, very rough mountainous.  
Soil, decomposed granite and granite outcrops, 4th rate.  
Timber, tamarack, whitebark pine, fir and hemlock.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush, manzanita, mountain mahogany.  
Grazing, poor.

Survey to Complete the E. Bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 18 E.

N.  $3^{\circ}21'E.$ , along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

Descend 230 ft. along NE. slope, thru scrub pine timber and granite boulders and outcrops.

9.50 Head of a fork of Mott Canyon, course N.  $50^{\circ}E.$ ; ascend 25 ft. along SE. slope.

27.00 Rocky spur, slopes N.  $55^{\circ}E.$ ; descend 200 ft. on NW. slope.

34.63 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Point for closing cor. of Ts. 12 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

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from which

A tamarack, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E.$ , 37 lks. dist., mkd. T12N R19E S6 CC BT.

A tamarack, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $84\text{-}3/4^{\circ}W.$ , 61 lks. dist., mkd. T12N R18E S1 CC BT.

Monument No. 6 on the California-Nevada State Boundary bears S.  $48^{\circ}42'E.$ , 5.25 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary line concurrently resurveyed under this group.

Descend 240 ft. on NW. slope.

45.75 Rocky ravine, middle fork of Mott Canyon, 10 lks. wide, course N.  $65^{\circ}E.$ ; ascend 10 ft.

46.20 Point for the  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. on W. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., 40.15 chs. in latitude from the NW. cor. of Tp.
