

RETRACEMENT OF PART OF IDAHO-NEVADA STATE BDY. LINE.

Chains.

TRUE LINE.

The 30th Mile cor. on the Idaho-Nevada State Bdy. is a lava stone, 8x6x12 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Thence

N. 86° 30' W., on Idaho-Nevada State Bdy.

Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.

50.82 The closing cor. of Tps. 16 S., Rs. 15 and 16 E., hereinafter described.

80.62 The 31st Mile cor., which is a lava stone, 10x10x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Land- rolling.

Soil- sandy and gravelly; 2nd rate.

Timber- none.

Undergrowth- sage.

Thence N. 88° 34' W., on State Bdy.

Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.

10.30 Mid-point for 1/4 sec. cor., as hereinafter determined. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, in mound of stone, with a stone, 3x3x3 ins., mkd. with a cross (X), deposited at base of post, for 1/4^sec cor. of fract. sec. 36, with brass cap mkd.
