 Bearings: to sharp mountain peak

 tance 8 miles, to rocky bluff and ridge
 N $35^{\circ} 04'$ W distance $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles, to
 clump trees or bush S $90^{\circ} 27'$ E dis-
 tance 3 miles.

 Sand mountains. Soil wet, 3rd mt.
 Thence descending to very rough basin
 between ridges 59 chains cross gulch
 thence to 4th mile. In ravine near
 large snow bank placed hood stones (18
 $\times 12 \times 5$ inches) marked on the North
 "I" on the path "N" on the East 43 M
 on the West 42 I - on either side
 of huge boulder in line.
 Pointing to low for bearings.
 Sand and soil same as last.
 Ascending over snow bank to small
 ridge 5 chains and descend to small
 mountain stream course down to
 North West 22 chains then ascend
 at 63 chains cross deep running
 creek to South. Thence over small
 ridge and descend stony side to
 end of 80 chains.
