

North Bdy. of frac. T. 23 N., R. 23 E.

Chains

June 12, 1911.

From the C.C. of Tps. 23 and 24 N., R. 23 E., on the reservation bdy., which is a volcanic stone 8x8x4 ins., above ground, firmly set, mkd. C C on W. face, S 35 on N. face, S 2 on S. face, and witnessed by pits and mound, west of and alongside of which I set an iron post for W.C., with brass cap stamped

T 24 N R 23 E S 35 in NW.

T 23 N S 2 in SW.

P L I R C C in W.

W C in S.

6 notches on N. and S. edges, from which

a limestone mass of rock 40x30x10 ft. brs. N. 21°40' E., 21 lks. dist., mkd. C.C. B.O. X.,

thence I run

West on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 35.

10.37 Intersect the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 35, which is a volcanic rock 8x8x3 ins. above ground, mkd. 1/4 on N. face and witnessed by pits and mound.

West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post for W.C. with brass cap stamped 1/4 S 35 W C in N. half.

12.00 Road, brs. N. and S.

50.39 Intersect the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, which is a volcanic stone 8x8x8 ins. above ground, mkd. 2 notches on E. and 4 on W., and witnessed by pits and mound.

West of and alongside stone, set an iron post for W.C. with brass cap stamped

T 24 N S 35 in NE. quadrant

R 23 E S 34 in NW. quadrant

W C in N.

4 notches on W. and 2 on E. edges

Land, rolling and grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2rd rate.

Thence I run

N. 89° 56' W. on a true line along the S. bdy. of sec. 34.

Over gently rolling prairie.
