80.00 Set an iron post for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32,
with brass cap stamped

T 25 N S 32 in NE. quadrant
R 21 E S 5 in SE. quadrant
T 24 N S 6 in SW. quadrant
S 31 in NW. quadrant
5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edge

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Cor. on steep NE. slope of mountain.

Land, mountainous, - grazing.
Soil, stony, 3rd rate.
