Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 6 and 31, with brass
cap stamped

- C C in E. edge, P L I R in middle
- T 28 N S 31 in NE. quadrant
- T 27 N R 20 E S 6 in SE. quadrant
- 6 notches on N. and S. edges

Dig pits 30x24x12 ins. on each line N. and S. of cor.

4 ft., and E. of cor. 8 ft. dist., and raise a mound of
