

North bdy. of T. 28 N. R. 19 E.

Chains

Sept. 11, 1911.

From the NE. cor. of T. 28 N., R. 19 E., I run West on a random line along the N. bdy. of sec. 1.

40.00 No trace of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 No trace of old cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36.

Set temp. cor.

From the temp. cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, I run West on a random line along the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

15.27 Falls 25 lks. S. of the C.C. of secs. 2 and 35, on the reservation bdy., which is a volcanic stone 12x12x12 ins. above ground, mkd. P L I R on E., C C on W., and witnessed by pits and mound.

The reported distance from the Tp. cor. to this C.C. is 97.46 chs.

Returning to the NE. cor. of T. 28 N. R. 19 E., thence I run

N. 89° 51' W. on a true line along the N. bdy. of sec. 1. Over Smoke Creek desert.

39.07 Set an iron post for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, with brass cap stamped $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 in S. half.

Dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

49.00 Leave barren desert, enter salt grass flat.

61.00 Leave salt grass flat, enter gently rolling land.

78.14 Set an iron post for the cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap stamped

T 28 N S 2 in SW. quadrant
R 19 E S 1 in SE. quadrant
1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges

Dig pits 24x24x12 ins., in each sec., 6 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, S of cor.

Land, 49.00 chs. barren desert. Balance gently rolling, grazing.

Soil, sandy and alkali, 3rd rate.
