

West bdy. of T. 29 N. R. 22 E.

Chains

October 3, 1911. At 8.30 a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40° 20' on the lat. arc, 3° 40½' S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, at the cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 N., Rgs. 21 and 22 E.

Thence I run

North on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Descending to draw.

7.50 Small draw, drains S. 65° W.

Thence ascend S. slope of low ridge.

13.50 Top of ascent on low ridge, brs. E. and W.

Thence descend broken N. slope.

26.00 Small draw, drains S. 60° W.

31.20 Small draw, drains S. 25° W.

Thence ascend gradual S. slope of ridge.

40.00 Set an iron post for the ¼ sec. cor. bet. secs. 31 and 36, with brass capstamped

¼ S 36 in W. half  
S 31 in E. half

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

72.50 Top of ascent on ridge, brs. E. and W.

Thence descend along NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap stamped

T 29 N S 30 in NE. quadrant  
R 22 E S 31 in SE. quadrant  
S 36 in SW. quadrant  
R 21 E S 25 in NW. quadrant  
1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, broken, mountainous, - grazing.  
Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd rate.

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From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, I run

North on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Continuing descent.

19.00 Bottom of descent in draw, drains S. 75° W.

Thence ascend SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post for the ¼ sec. cor. bet. secs. 25 and 30,
