for witness cor. to the 5 Mile Post.

Land rolling, grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

From the 5 Mile Post, I run

39.80 N. 27° 21' E. on a random line along the reservation bdy.
to the
Falls 9 lks. left of the 5½ Mile Post, which is a granite
stone, 20x12x10 ins. above ground, mkd. 5½ M on SW.,
P.L. on E., and witnessed by pits and mound.

Returning to the 5 Mile Post, thence I run

N. 27° 29' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.
Over gently rolling land.
39.80 The 5½ Mile Post. West of and alongside the stone, set
an iron post, with brass cap stamped
P L I R W C 5½ M P, in NW. half, for witness cor.
to the 5½ Mile Post.

Land, rolling, grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

From the 5½ Mile Post, I run

N. 27° 26' E. on a true line along reservation bdy., (my
flagman at the 6 Mile Post being plainly visible).
Over gently rolling land.

39.90 Intersect the 6 Mile Post, which is a granite stone,
24x12x12 ins. above ground, mkd. 6 M on SW., P.L. on
E. and witnessed by pits and mound.

West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post, with
brass cap stamped P L I R W C 6 M P, in NW. half,
for witness cor. to 6 Mile Post.

Land, rolling, - grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

From the 6 Mile Post, I run

N. 27° 29' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.
