Chains

Returning to the 11½ Mile Post, thence I run
N. 21° 50' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.
Over mountainous land.

5.27 The C.C. of secs. 3 and 34.

5.75 Draw, drains W.

6.50 Summit of ridge, brs. E. and W.

Thence descend along broken W. slope.

28.00 Deep gulch, course S. 40° W.

29.00 Begin steep ascent of ridge, brs. NE. and SW.

31.00 Summit of ascent on ridge, brs. E. and W.

Begin steep descent into gulch.

36.50 Dry wash at bottom of deep gulch, course S. 15° W.

40.39 The 12 Mile Post. West of and alongside the stone, set
an iron post, with brass cap stamped P L I R W C
12 M P in W. half, for witness cor. to 12 Mile Post.

Land, broken, mountainous, and barren.
Soil, stony, 3rd rate.

From the 12 Mile Post, I run

N. 21° 50' W. on a random line along the reservation bdy.

40.02 Intersect the 12½ Mile Post, which is a granite stone,
24x16x8 ins. above ground, marked 12½ M on SE., P L
on NE. face, and witnessed by a mound of stone to NW.

Returning to the 12 Mile Post, thence I run

N. 21° 50' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.
Ascending ridge.

4.00 Summit of low ridge, brs. E. and W.

Thence begin descent.

9.00 Wash, course S. 35° E.

Bottom of descent, begin ascent.

14.00 Summit of ascent, brs. NE. and SW.

Begin descent to wash.

17.00 Same wash, course S. 10° W. Thence ascend.

23.00 Summit of ascent on low ridge, brs. E. and W.

Thence gradual descent to rocky level plateau.
