iron post, with brass cap stamped P L I R W C 18
M P, in W. half, for witness cor. to 18 Mile post.

Land, broken, mountainous and barren.
Soil, stony, 3rd rate.

June 6, 1911.

From the 18 Mile Post, I run

N. 21° 55' W. along the reservation bdy.- on random line.

3.72 Intersect the C.C. of secs. 5 and 32, of Tps. 22 and 23
N., R. 24 E.

32.75 Intersect the C.C. of secs. 31 and 32.

40.05 Intersect the 18½ Mile Post, which is a volcanic rock,
16x12x10 ins. above ground, mkd. 18½ M on SE., and P L
on NE., witnessed by a mound of stone, NW. of cor.

Returning to the 18 Mile Post, thence I run

N. 21° 55' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.

3.72 The C.C. of secs. 5 and 32.

32.75 The C. C. of secs. 31 and 32.

40.05 The 18½ Mile Post. West of and alongside the rock, set
an iron post, with brass cap stamped P L I R W C
18½ M P, in W. half, for witness cor. to the 18½
Mile Post.

Land, nearly level, - grazing.
Soil, sandy loam, 1st rate.

From the 18½ Mile Post, I run

N. 21° 55' W. on a random line along the reservation bdy.

40.05 Intersect the 19 Mile Post, which is a volcanic stone,
18x18x12 ins. above ground, mkd. 19 M on top, P L on S.,
witnessed by pits and mound.

Returning to the 18½ Mile Post, thence I run

N. 21° 55' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.

Over nearly level land.

40.05 The 19 Mile Post. West of and alongside the stone, set
