

Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation Boundary.

Chains.

Over broken mountainous land.

- 8.88 Low ridge, brs. NW. and SE.
- 17.40 Small draw, drains S.
- 26.20 Small draw, drains S.
- 32.18 Small draw, drains S.
- 37.00 Small draw, drains SE.
- 40.18 The 62 Mile Post.

West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post for W.C., with brass cap stamped P L I R 62 M P W C in S.half.

Land, broken, mountainous, - grazing.
Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.

----- Oct. 2, 1911. -----

Sept. 18, 1911. At 8.30 a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40° 22' on the lat. arc, 2° 09½' N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar at the 62 M.P.

Thence I run

N. 85° W. on a random line along the reservation bdy.

- 39.91 Falls 3 lks. ^{to the} left of the 62½ Mile Post, which is a granite stone, 12x12x8 ins., above ground, mkd. 62½ M on E., P.L. on N., and witnessed by pits and mound.

Returning to the 62 Mile Post, thence I run

N. 84° 57' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.

Over broken mountainous land.

- 6.50 Small draw, drains SE.
- 26.10 Drain, course S. 10° E.

Mountain creek, 2 lks. wide, from opening 4.00 chs.

N. 10° W.

- 39.91 The 62½ Mile Post.

West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post for W.C. with brass cap stamped P L I R 62½ M P W C, in S. half.

Soil, stony, 3rd rate.
