

## Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation Boundary

## Chains

with brass cap stamped P L I R 74 M P W C in  
S. half. Dig pits 36x36x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 4  
ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 5 ft. base, 2½  
ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, level desert, - barren.  
Soil, sandy, alkali, 3rd rate.

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From the 74 Mile Post, I run  
N. 85° 10' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,  
(flagman at 74½ M.P. being visible)  
Over level desert land.

40.03 Intersect the 74½ Mile post, which is a volcanic rock,  
22x12x8 ins., above ground, marks in evidence but not  
legible.

West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post for W.C.,  
with brass cap stamped P L I R 74½ M P W C in  
S. half. Dig pits 36x36x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 4 ft.  
dist., and raise a mound of earth 5 ft. base, 2½ ft.  
high, S. of cor.

Land, level, desert, - barren.  
Soil, sandy, alkali, 3rd rate.

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From the 74½ Mile Post, I run  
N. 85° 10' W. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,  
(flagman at the 75 M.P. being visible)  
Over level desert land.

40.00 Intersect the 75 M.P., which is a volcanic rock 12x12x12  
ins. above ground, marks in evidence but not legible,  
witnessed by pits and mound.

West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post for W.C.,  
with brass cap stamped P L I R 75 M P W C in  
S. half.

Land, level desert, barren.  
Soil, sandy, alkali, 3rd rate.

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
