

Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation Boundary

Chains

From the 85½ Mile Post, I run

S. 14° 58' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,
(a flag at the 86 M.P. being plainly visible.)

Descending S. slope of ridge.

15.00 Bottom of descent.

Thence over nearly level flat.

39.94 Intersect the 86 Mile Post, which is a volcanic rock,
14x12x6 ins., above ground, mkd. 86 M on NW., P L
on W., and witnessed by a mound of stone SE.

West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post for W.C.,
with brass cap stamped P L I R 86 M P W C, in
E. half.

Land, rolling, - grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

From the 86 Mile Post, I run

S. 14° 53' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,
(a flag at the 86½ Mile Post being plainly visible)

Over nearly level flat.

25.25 Wash, course S. 70° W.

36.94 Intersect the old C.C. of secs. 6 and 31, bet. Tps. 27
referring to surveys off the reservation
and 28 N., R. 20 E., hereafter described.

39.15 Road, brs. S. 60° W. and N. 60° E.

40.00 Intersect the 86½ Mile Post, which is a volcanic stone,
18x16x6 ins., above ground, mkd. 86½ M.P. on NW.,
P L on W., and witnessec by pits and mound.

West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post for W.C.
with brass cap stamped P L I R 86½ M P W C in
E. half.

Land, nearly level.
Soil, alkali, 3rd rate.

From the 86½ Mile Post, I run

S. 14° 53' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,
(the 87 M.P., being plainly visible)
