Over rolling land.

40.00 Intersect the 93 $\frac{1}{2}$ Mile Post, which is a volcanic rock,
14x12x8 ins., above ground, mkd. 93 $\frac{1}{2}$ M on NW., P.L.
on W., and witnessed by a mound of stone to SE.

West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post for W.C.,
with brass cap stamped P L I R 93 $\frac{1}{2}$ M P W C in
E. half.

Land, rolling, - grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

From the 93 $\frac{1}{2}$ Mile Post, I run

S. 15° 00' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,
(the 94 M.P. being plainly visible)

Over rolling land.

26.00 Falls 3 lks. E. of the old C.C. of secs. 4 and 9, here-
after described.

32.50 Wash, course E.

40.00 Intersect the 94 Mile Post, which is a volcanic rock
20x16x8 ins. above ground, mkd. 94 M on NW., P.L. on
W., and witnessed by pits and mound.

West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post for W.C.,
with brass cap stamped P L I R 94 M P W C in
E. half.

Land, rolling, - grazing.
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

From the 94 Mile Post, I run

S. 15° 00' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.,
(the 94 $\frac{1}{2}$ M.P. being plainly visible)

Over rolling land.

13.50 Road to Red Light, brs. N. 15° E. and S. 15° W.

39.50 Wash, course E.
