Chains

40.06 Falls 9 lks. ^{to the} left of the 133 Mile Post, which is a basaltic rock, 14x14x12 ins., above ground, mkd. P L I R on E., and 133 M on N. faces, and witnessed by a mound of stone to E.

Returning to the 132½ Mile Post, thence I run S. 20° 37' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy. Over broken SE. slope.

.08 The C.C. of secs. 1 and 12, referring to surveys off the reservation.

4.38 The C.C. of secs. 1 and 12, referring to surveys on the reservation.

7.00 Dry wash, course E.

40.06 The 133 Mile Post. West of and alongside the rock, set an iron post, with brass cap stamped P L I R W C 133 M P, in NE. half, for witness cor. to the 133 Mile Post.

Land, broken E. slope, - grazing.
Soil, rocky, 2nd rate.

From the 133 Mile Post, I run

S. 20° 45' E. on a random line along the reservation bdy.

40.18 Falls 9 lks. ^{to the} left of the 133½ Mile Post, which is a granite stone, 24x12x12 ins. above ground, mkd. P L I R on E., 133½ M on N., and witnessed by a mound of stone, to E.

Returning to the 133 Mile Post, thence I run S. 20° 37' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy. Over gradual SE. slope.

7.00 Dry wash, course SE.

40.18 The 133½ Mile Post. West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post, with brass cap stamped P L I R W C 133½ M P.

Land, broken SE. slope, - grazing.
Soil, sandy and stony, 2nd rate.
