Returning to the 135 Mile Post, thence I run

S. 20° 30' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.

Over gently sloping land.

11.58 The C.C. for secs. 19 and 24, hereafter described, in notes of township exteriors.

40.02 The 135½ Mile post. West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post, with brass cap stamped
P L I R W C 135½ M P, in NE. half, for witness cor. to the 135½ Mile Post.

Land, gently sloping, agricultural.
Soil, sandy loam, 1st rate.

From the 135½ Mile Post, I run

S. 20° 45' E. on a random line along the reservation bdy.

21.73 Falls 3 lks. ^{to the} left of the C.C. of secs. 19 and 30.

40.05 Falls 5 lks. ^{to the} left of the 136 Mile Post, which is a granite stone, 12x12x8 ins., above ground, mkd. 136 M on N. No other markings. Witnessed by pits and mound.

Returning to the 135½ Mile Post, thence I run

S. 20° 41' E. on a true line along the reservation bdy.

Over nearly level land.

21.73 The C.C. of secs. 19 and 30, hereafter described.

34.60 Road, brs. NE. and SW.

40.05 The 136 Mile Post. West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post with brass cap stamped
P L I R W C 136 M P, in NE. half, for witness cor. to the 136 Mile Post.

Land, nearly level, - agricultural.
Soil, sandy loam, 1st rate.

From the 136 Mile Post, I run

S. 20° 45' E. on a random line along the reservation bdy.

40.04 Falls 2 lks. ^{to the} left of the 136½ Mile Post, which is a granite stone, 12x12x10 ins. above ground, - marks illegible witnessed by pits and mound.
